4. What is a missionary disciple? Do you see yourself as a missionary disciple now? Why or why not? How willing are you to be a missionary disciple, and in what ways can you be a missionary disciple to others?

5. What does it look like to stand up for your faith on a day-to-day basis? What makes it hard to stand up for your faith?

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Youth Witness: *Olivia Warden*

1. Candidate: Share with your sponsor why you chose him/her? What about your sponsor's faith do you admire and hope to model?
2. Have you ever felt on fire for the faith? What was this experience like? Do you want to be bold in the faith?
