Pilgrim Packing List

Clothing: *(Avg. temp 29-47 degrees)*

- Gloves (waterproof)
- Overcoat (waterproof)
- Boots (waterproof)
- Hat
- Scarf (provided!)
- Poncho
- Warm Layers of Clothing

Personal Items:

- Rosary
- Toothbrush
- Basic Toiletries and Small Towel
- Any Personal Medications (to be given to your chaperone)
- Refillable Water Bottle
- Flashlight
- Things to Do (homework, deck of cards, books, etc.)
- Phone charger

For Stay at Host Parish:

- Sleeping Bag and Pillow (in a sealed plastic bag with your name clearly labeled on outside of bag)
- Sleeping Pad (if desired)
- *Showers Are Not Available During the Pilgrimage

Food:

- Cash for Meals & Metro Ticket (\$50)
- Snacks in a Small Backpack (for bus rides, and Friday/Saturday morning)
- Hefty snacks/lunch for Friday mid-day
- If you have food allergies, please make sure this is clearly communicated with trip organizers well in advance of pilgrimage

For Bus Ride:

- Small Travel Pillow and Blanket
- Small Backpack with Carry-Ons

*From the time we depart until Friday evening, you will have **no access** to luggage underneath busses. Please bring everything you would like to have during the March with you on board the bus (coat, poncho, etc. in your small carry-on backpack). You will have access to items underneath the bus once again on Friday evening at our host parishes.

We expect that masks will be required on the busses and while indoors at various events / Masses.

Electronics:

- We encourage parents and students to discuss what electronics and media are needed to promote the mission of the March for Life Pilgrimage and which electronics should stay behind because they will not further the mission and spirit of the pilgrimage.
- Any personal media (music, movies, games, phones, etc.) is a privilege on this trip; content must meet with leaders' approval. Use must remain morally appropriate, in no way offensive, and quiet enough to avoid disturbing neighbors. Violators may have electronics confiscated.
- Any cyber bullying, pornography, or illegal downloading is absolutely forbidden on the pilgrimage

What not to bring: Personal valuables | Energy drinks | Illegal or immoral items | Cigarettes | E-cigarettes | Unprescribed drugs | Anything that might disturb the well-being of other pilgrims | Pocket knives | Weapons
