Dear Pastors, Chaplains, Youth Ministers, and Pastoral Ministers,

Diocesan Youth Leadership (DYL) is a unique leadership, faith formation, and pastoral training opportunity offered to youth in grades 10-12 in our diocese. Representing our Catholic high schools and parishes, this team advocates for the needs of our young people at a diocesan level. Members of DYL play a crucial role in spreading the joy of the Gospel at youth events, particularly at the Diocesan Confirmation Retreats, and other regional and diocesan events. They are given the opportunity to plan, give witness talks, lead discussions, and implement creative ideas for bringing the young people of our diocese together to advocate and pray for causes they are passionate about. This year, members of our team have planned a retreat day for young women titled, "Beloved Daughters" to help young women aged 16-22 in their discernment. Our team members saw a need, made recommendations, and have felt empowered to help bring about something new. Members of DYL are called to embody joyful discipleship and heartfelt evangelization in their communities. We invite you to please prayerfully consider the young people at your parishes and schools who would benefit from the opportunity of DYL.

Those you nominate should be young people who will at least be going into their sophomore year, who are already actively involved in your parish or school, who are committed to living their Catholic faith joyfully, who desire to grow in their relationship with Christ, and who can commit to the leadership role being offered to them. All accepted members of Diocesan Youth Leadership will be notified before June 20, 2023.

Diocesan Youth Leaders will help plan and lead Diocesan events such as the:

Diocesan Confirmation Retreat: Saturday, September, 30 2023 / a Saturday in March of 2024)
Other Diocesan Events (March for Life, Eucharistic Revival Events, Beloved Daughters Retreat).

Additionally, Diocesan Youth Leaders will help provide a link between parish ministry and Diocesan initiatives. Diocesan Youth Leaders will represent the youth of the Diocese to bring their needs and concerns before youth ministry leaders from around the Diocese. Finally, Diocesan Youth Leaders will also be empowered to help create and lead ideas of their own.

The 2023-2024 Diocesan Youth leadership Team will meet for a kick-off event at Pokagon State Park on June 22, 2023.
