Diocesan Youth Leaders will help plan and lead Diocesan events such as the: Diocesan Confirmation Retreat: Saturday, September, 30 2023 / a Saturday in March of 2024) Other Diocesan Events (March for Life, Eucharistic Revival Events, Beloved Daughters Retreat).

Diocesan Youth Leaders will represent the youth of the Diocese to bring their needs and concerns before youth ministry leaders from around the Diocese.
