BE FORMED

Read a Vatican document on the Eucharist, such as *Ecclesia de Eucharistia* or *Sacramentum Caritatis*, or read *The Mystery of Eucharist in the Life of the Church* by the U.S. Bishops (all free online).

Read and reflect on Eucharistic Scripture: John Chapter 6, Matthew 26:17-30, Acts 2:42, 1 Corinthians 10:16-22, 1 Corinthians 11:20-34.

Read a book on the Eucharist.

Listen to one of Bishop Rhoades' many talks or podcasts episodes on the Eucharist.

Watch a video or series on the Eucharist.

ENCOUNTER CHRIST

Receive forgiveness in the Sacrament of Reconciliation once in Lent and once in Advent.

Spend time with Christ for 60 minutes of Eucharistic adoration (at once or broken into chunks). If you already go often, try spending an extra hour in adoration this Parish Year.

Make one visit to the Blessed Sacrament outside of a structured event.

Participate in a Eucharistic procession.

Attend five daily Masses.

Attend a talk for one 40 hours mission night - find dates at diocesefwsb.org/eucharist.

View a Eucharistic miracles exhibit. Find these and other Eucharistic Revival events at diocesefwsb.org/Eucharist.
